T206 White Borders - We have two additional variations to report in T206. One, recently discovered by Washington area store owner Bill Huggins involves a T206 Doyle card. The Doyle in question is the variety that does not carry a league designation. This card, for unknown reasons has always been carried with an "A.L." designation. No longer. Huggins' discovery clearly shows the card of Doyle with a "N.Y. Nat'l" designation. The new card has to be considered an important discovery and should be listed in T206 checklists.



The second T206 variation is one that's been known for a while and also involves a caption - for minor leaguer Bud Sharpe of Newark. There is a printing variation of the card which represents the last name to be "Shappe" instead of "Sharpe". It's an interesting variation and one that could carry some value to T206 collectors, but not on the same level as the Doyle card.
