

Interesting Cards and Items

TOJ subscriber and variations expert Keith Olbermann has sent us an interesting item to study. The card was, what appeared to be a common T206 of Simon Nicholls. The interesting aspect of the card, as Keith pointed out, was that Nicholls cap carried a very clear outline of an "A" on his cap. His T206 card very clearly shows his cap to be blank (white), despite a large "A" on his uniform. Nicholls was an Athletic in fielder thru the 1909 season and perhaps an attempt was made to remove the "A" from his cap after he left the Athletics. In any case, an interesting card which would probably best be classified as a "proof".
